 - (ii) Original Survey Plan Two (2) copies.
 - (iii) Passport Photograph One (1) copy per applicant
 - (iv) Current Tax Clearance Certificate of the applicant(s).

2. Procedure For Processing Certificate Of Statutory Right Of Occupancy

- i. Payment of Initial deposits.

- iii. Print out of the online form duly filled and signed.
- iv. Inspection of site by relevant officers from Town Planning and Lands Departments and Office of the Surveyor-General.
- v. Survey Investigation at the Office of Surveyor-General.
- vi. Physical Planning clearance of the application.
- vii. Advertisement of application.
- viii. Computation and payment of Issuance fee.
- ix. Preparation of Certificate of Statutory Right of Occupancy and signing by applicant(s).
- x. Transmission of file to Mr. Governor for endorsement.
- xi. Stamping of the Certificate at the Osun Internal Revenue Service.
- xii. Registration of the Certificate at the Lands Registry.
- xiii. Collection of Certificate of Statutory Right of Occupancy.
